PROFILE

Jesse has experience across a range of substantive and regulatory areas. He has sued the federal government and has also been one of its top law-enforcement officials; he has represented states and has also navigated their regulatory agencies on behalf of clients; and he has represented companies in complex commercial disputes, both as defendants and plaintiffs. Jesse serves as the co-leader of the firm's Appellate practice group and regularly briefs and argues high-stakes appeals across the country.

Before joining the firm, Jesse was the Acting Associate Attorney General at the United States Department of Justice. In that role, he oversaw the civil and criminal work of the Antitrust, Civil, Civil Rights, Environment and Natural Resources, and Tax Divisions. During Jesse's tenure, the Associate's office closely managed the Department's most significant litigation, including matters involving large financial institutions, healthcare companies, automakers, energy companies, and state and local governments. In addition, Jesse served as Chair of DOJ's Regulatory Reform Task Force and Vice Chair of DOJ's Task Force on Market Integrity and Consumer Fraud. Jesse regularly provided legal and strategic advice to the highest-level decision

Jesse served for three years as the secretary of Florida's labor, economic-development, and land-use agency, the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity. Before that, he served as Governor (now Senator) Rick Scott's general counsel.

Jesse maintains offices in both Washington D.C. and Florida. From Washington, he focuses on federal litigation and crisis management. In Florida, in addition to federal litigation, Jesse employs his knowledge of state government and regulation to help clients in courts across the state, from trial through the Florida Supreme Court.

Outside of the firm, Jesse continues his public service. He is a public member of the Administrative Conference of the United States, a federal agency charged with identifying ways to improve federal agency administrative procedures; vice chair of the Florida Supreme Court Judicial Nominating Commission, a state commission that provides the governor with nominees for appointment to the Florida Supreme Court; and a trustee of the Florida Polytechnic University, one of Florida's 12 public universities and the only one focused solely on STEM degrees.
