WHETHER SHE'S LITIGATING CLASS ACTIONS, intellectual property cases or disputes tied to sex trafficking and abuse, Sigrid McCawley is winning major battles on behalf of her clients. McCawley has for years been focused on her pro bono representation of the victims of sex offender Jeffrey Epstein, helping to build the record of evidence that led to his arrest on federal sex trafficking charges in 2019. She filed and later settled a defamation suit against an Epstein associate on behalf of Virginia Roberts Giuffre, one of Epstein's victims. McCawley also secured a settlement on behalf of Sarah Ransome, another of Epstein's victims, and is representing Maria and Annie Farmer and others who have come forward since Epstein's arrest. Beyond her work related to Epstein, McCawley was also a key member of a team that obtained a \$100 million class settlement that was disbursed in 2018 in a securities fraud case against Halliburton that twice went to the U.S. Supreme Court.
